Workshop is planned for September 14 in Augusta

HELENA, MONTANA – Registration is open to local landowners for a day-long workshop in Augusta on Riparian Grazing for Flood Resilience on September 14. The workshop is being sponsored by the Lewis and Clark Conservation District and the Montana Association of Conservation Districts.

“We are excited to bring two great speakers to the Augusta area to talk with local landowners about stream bank erosion, riparian grazing, and conservation programs that are available,” said Chris Evans, of the Lewis and Clark Conservation District.

Dr. Clayton Marlow, a professor at Montana State University, will discuss monitoring and riparian grazing management. The workshop is open to landowners in the area.
